Job Available: Resourcing Faith@5: Admin, Online community, and Social Media Profile

Faith@5 is a joint activity of Jesmond Park Uniting Church and New Lambton Uniting Church.

We gather at 5pm on the second and fourth Saturday of the month during school terms at Jesmond Park Uniting Church, and currently have between 50 and 60 people attending.

We share in a time of worship and faith-based activity followed by a shared meal.

We are looking for a part time admin officer for 4 hours a week.

Faith@5 is a diverse and inclusive community which seeks to grow Christ-centred communities through:

- Creating space for God in open and flexible ways.
- Connecting and empowering our community especially the kids and teens.
- Providing an open space, where relationships with people of faith are developed, where stories of faith are shared, and those who are unsure of where they stand in relation to all things church, Jesus, and God can explore that freely.

This role will help Faith@5 engage in a new way with the local and broader community including non-church goers and build on the foundation already in place. The role will coordinate the creation and maintenance of a social media profile. An online presence will help Faith@5 to further connect and discover what the needs of local families, children and teens, regardless of any preexisting connection to church of any form. It will also provide an opportunity to connect with university students who live locally and might be looking for somewhere to worship and connect with a church community close to the campus. The position will work closely alongside, and with the support of, the core leadership of the Faith@5 team.

This role will take responsibility for the following areas:

- Respond to requests for information via the web or email.
- Maintain an up-to-date schedule of Faith@5 gatherings for use online and in print.
- Update online profiles/pages regularly with upcoming events and items of interest.
- Assist where appropriate with purchasing materials for use at Faith@5.
- Assist in preparing reports for JPUC and NLUC Church Council meetings when requested.
- Online community building, initially through setting up and providing input to WhatsApp groups or similar, and other methods as the role is established and other methods become suitable.
- Assist the volunteers in claiming for expenses incurred as part of Faith@5.



Appeal for Gaza

The human catastrophe in Gaza is unrelenting. Even when the bombs stop falling, Gaza is broken. Homes and buildings are shattered and the suffering never ends.

How can we give tangible support to Palestine?

Truckloads of aid are slowly making their way into Gaza from Egypt. Up to 6 inspections of every load, with authorisation from the Egyptian Red Crescent, government and Israeli authorities are needed.

Operation Hope has identified a UK-registered charity which has been able to deliver their first truck-load of supplies into Gaza. The charity 'Refugee Biriyani and Bananas' (RBB) has been able to purchase a truck load of supplies for Gaza. The truck departed Cairo on 9 February, and arrived in Gaza 3 weeks later after all the required checks and inspections.

The delivery was supervised by the Egyptian Red Crescent and the Palestinian Red Crescent. Trusted and referencechecked relatives and friends known personally to the charity organisers conducted the aid distribution in Gaza.

Donate to purchase supplies

Operation Hope Australia has launched an appeal to fund the next truckload of supplies. The will cost up to £35,000 (\$60,000). Limited supplies are sometimes available in Gaza, so these will also be purchased if possible.

Your donation will be handled securely and donations over \$2 are tax deductible.
